Procedures/Activity	What is the TEACHER doing?	What are the STUDENTS doing?
Introductions / warm-up (5-8 min)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Self Introduction of teachers - Ask question “What room are you in?” 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Listen to introductions and ask questions - Speak about the room they are in
What makes you nervous? (15 min)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Show video clip - Interactive Whiteboard activity on “What makes you nervous?” - Technique for grounding self in the room you are in. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Watch and listen to video clip - Write on interactive whiteboard and discuss answers - Listen to and read about the technique. - Asking questions.
Show and Tell (15 min)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Explain activity - Describe an object in the teacher’s room 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Listening to teachers and peers - Speak about an object in their room - Ask and answer questions
Show and Tell Connection Game (20 min)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Explain the activity - Model the activity between the two teachers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Listening to teachers and peers - Speak about an object in their room and connect it to the previous person’s object - Ask and answer questions
