- Love the video clip about memories! This is a great metaphorical way for students to think about their learning and a great introduction to the review activity.
- An excellent series of student-centred activities for the first half of the class that ensured that students are engaged throughout the lesson (collaborate board, fill-in-the blanks activity) and provide you with opportunities for

assessment. The second part of the class became “question-elicited response” which is a more teacher-directed technique and fewer students participate. Is there a different way to do this that could keep more students participating?

- You paced the lesson well by giving students time frames for completing a task.
- I couldn't see what the students were writing in Nearpod from the student view.
- Can you think of some additional ways for eliciting responses from students? Another student teacher put the names of students into a jar and would randomly choose a name which kept everyone on their toes.
- I know it can be awkward with the silence when students are working on a task, but it's so important to give students time in class particularly with writing tasks.
- You dealt with tech issues in a calm and confident manner.
- Loved the way you ended by letting students know that they have helped to create core memories for you. Great way to show gratitude.
