

Conversation Club Lesson Plan

October 21 2020 - Evan and Kathy

Class Description

Online conversation club meeting that has voluntary attendance of university students at varying levels of English use. Students are attending from varying locations around the world.

Terminal Objective

Students will be able to have a conversation about their favourite place in the world.

Enabling Objectives

- Have students think about their favourite place in terms of the 5 W questions (Who do/would they go with? What did/would they do there? Where is it? When did/would they go there? Why did they choose that place?)
- Have students describe their favourite place
- Ask and encourage questions to elicit further detail

Materials & Equipment

- PowerPoint presentation (*see attached)
- Big Blue Button online platform with interactive whiteboard enabled

Procedures/Activity	What is the TEACHER doing?	What are the STUDENTS doing?
Warm up Activity (How are you feeling?) (15 min)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Self-introductions by teachers- Ask students to place an emoji in the chat function to describe how they are feeling- Ask students to take turns speaking about where they are located, the emoji they chose and how they are feeling	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Listening to other people's introductions and responding or asking questions- Introducing themselves and talking about where they are located and how they feel
Main Activity (Your favourite place) (35 min)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Teachers each introduce their favourite place(s)- Ask student to mark their favourite place on the map using the interactive whiteboard- Have each student talk about their favourite place- Prompt further conversation with additional questions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Listening to other people's favourite places and responding or asking questions- Sharing information about their favourite place, keeping in consideration the questions provided
Exit Ticket (5 min)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Ask students to identify the individual they would take with them when visiting their favourite place	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Respond and leave

Evaluation/Assessment

The exit ticket is used as the measurement of comprehension.
